This Agrément Certificate Product Sheet⁽¹⁾ relates to TecCast Architectural Cast Stone, moulded, non-loadbearing units such as window heads and cills, door surrounds, string courses and cornices, used as a substitute for natural stone architectural dressings.

KEY FACTORS ASSESSED

Weather resistance — the product has good resistance to weathering and can withstand freezing conditions without detriment (see section 6).

Behaviour in relation to fire — the product contains less than 1% of organic matter and, therefore, is defined as non-combustible and is unrestricted under the national Building Regulations (see section 7).

Resistance to mechanical damage — the resistance of the product to impact and abrasion will be at least equivalent to that of cast stone manufactured to BS 1217 : 2008 (see section 8).

Durability — under non-loadbearing conditions, the product will continue to perform effectively for the lifetime of the building (see section 10).
